Nebraska High School Bowling Coaches Association

Open to All NHSBCA Teams that bowled at least 6 Tournaments.

1. The Nebr. High School Bowling Championship is sponsored by the Nebr. High School Coaches Assoc. It is open to all qualified teams that qualified through state wide qualifying tournaments.
 2. All players must be in good academic standing and attending a Neb. high school (public or private). All students must be attending or be a midterm graduate of one particular high school or approved by tournament management following NHSBCA qualifying rules.
 - a. All players must be in grades 9th through 12th.
 - b. Only two boy's team and two girl's team may qualify from one school.
 - c. All players must be from the school they bowl with. A school may combine players from another school or schools to form a team, if that school or schools doesn't have a team. **All players must be able to show proof of school attending. (Student ID card)**
 - d. All players must go to a Nebr. High School or a registered Nebraska Home Study. (Must be able to show proof of registration.) If none available use the absent bowlers chart by NHSBCA Rules.
 - e. If a team is short a player due to sickness – weather or an emergency the tournament director may loan a player from another team.
 3. The Neb. High School Championship is USBC sanctioned. All players must be USBC/Youth sanctioned or pay a \$2.00 participation fee.
 4. Entry fee is \$85 Boys, (\$60 Bowling, and \$25 Awards). Entry fee is \$70 Girls (\$56 Bowling and \$14 Awards).
 5. Playing strength of each team shall be five bowlers Boys and 4 Bowlers Girls, although a team's roster may carry up to 7 players. If a team is short bowler(s) subs at the tournament may be used. **If absent bowlers and no subs than use the Absent bowler chart in the NHSBCA Rules.**
 6. All competition will be scratch.
 7. Substitutions are not allowed during a match except in case of accident or extreme injury. Line-up may change, however for a subsequent game.
 8. There will be a separate boys division and girls division:
 9. **Tournament format: Sun. Feb. 21, 2016 JV Boys and Girls Qualifying: 3 Regular, and 3 Bakers then to Cut top 8.**
 10. Awards: Awards will be furnished by the NHSBCA and any money left over from entry fee will be use for awards.
All awards funds will be returned 100%.
 - 1st -2nd - 3rd - 4th place Medals (boys)
 - 1st -2nd - 3rd - 4th place Medals (girls)
 - All tournament team certificates
 - High game & High series plaques both boy and girl.
- Scholarships** and amounts will be determined by NHSBCA. All Scholarship money will be placed in a USBC Smart Account in bowler's name.
11. Only 2 coaches per team and tournament officials will be allowed in bowling area. All other spectators must remain behind bowling area.
 12. Teams may stand during competition but must remain in their half of bowling area. Please respect spectators view.
 13. All players, coaches and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and / gestures will not be tolerated and may result in a player or team being extracted from tournament.
 14. Payment: **All payment must be made in advance. Check made payable to Neb. High School Bowling Coaches Assoc.**
 15. Dress code: Team shirts if at all possible. No ball caps - No clothing violating USBC rules.
 16. Any Rule not covered here will be settled in accordance to USBC Playing Rules.
 17. Tournament Directors to govern any situations not covered here.
 18. Any non-sufficient fund check issued by a coach in the NHSBCA will be assessed whatever fee we are charged along with the amount of the check & must be paid as soon as possible.
