- 1. The Millard Invitational Varsity Tournament is sponsored by the Millard Bowling Teams and is open to all bowling teams of 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in good academic standing and attending a school (public or private). Teams are composed of students attending a particular school unless approved by the tournament director prior to the tournament. In case of bad weather or player does not show, a team may borrow another team's player only by approval from the tournament director. This is a fun time event.
- 2. The USBC certifies the Millard Invitational Tournament. Accordingly, all participants must be certified through the USBC. Any bowler not sanctioned must pay \$2.00 participation fee.
- 3. Entry fee is \$75.00 per team, for boys, and \$70.00 for girls. <u>Please pay in advance</u>. \$4.00 per team entry will go to the NHSCA to run the Nebraska High School Championships, any leftover will go to the trophy fund and scholarships.
- 4. The top two highest finishing boys and girls teams that are not yet qualified for state, will qualify for the Nebraska High School Championships.
- 5. There will be separate divisions for boys' and girls' teams.
- 6. Playing strength of each team will consist of 5 bowlers for boys and 4 bowlers for girls. Roster may contain up to 8 bowlers at a time, but no straw bowlers allowed. Absent bowler chart:

- 7. All competition will be scratch, no handicap.
- 8. Substitutions are not allowed during a match except in case of extreme accident or injury. Line-up may change, however for a subsequent match.
- 9. Tournament format:
  - a. All teams will bowl 3 regular games of qualifying.
  - b. Teams will be seeded into the finals based on qualifying positions.
  - c. Finals will consist of 3 rounds of best 2 of 3 baker matches.
  - d. All teams will bowl each round. There is no cut!
- 10. All players, coaches, and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and/or gestures will not be tolerated and may result in a player or team being ejected from the tournament.
- 11. Players, two coaches per team, and the tournament officials only will be allowed in the bowling area.

  All other spectators must remain behind the bowling area.
- 12. There will be no shorts or hats allowed by the bowler or coaches, unless for a medical reason. No electronic devices in the bowling area, which includes cell phones, iPods, iPads, ect.
- 13. Entries will be accepted on first come, first serve basis. Contact the tournament director by Sunday, December 3.
- 14. Awards will be handed out at the conclusion of the finals of both boys and girls.
- 15. There will be a \$50.00 scholarship award to one boy and one girl for the high game and series. The scholarship must be used within 6 years of graduation. The fund will be held in the SMART FUND ACCOUNT 2058.
- 16. Any rule not covered here will be settles in accordance to USBC playing rules.
