Tournament Rules

- 1. The Bellevue Invitational Tournament is sponsored by the Bellevue Area Bowling Clubs and is open to all bowling teams of high school students in good academic standing and attending a High School (public or private). Teams are composed of students attending one particular school unless approved by Tournament Director prior to tournament. In case of bad weather or player not showing up, a team may borrow another team's player only by approval of Tournament Director. This is a fun time tournament.
- 2. The Bellevue Invitational Varity High School & JV Tournament will be USBC Certified. Accordingly, all participants must be USBC Youth members. Any bowler not a USBC Youth member must pay \$2.00 participation fee.
- 3. Entry Fee is \$80.00 per team Please pay in advance!! Bowling \$50.00 Awards \$15.00 Expenses \$10.00 and \$5.00 to the NHSCA to run the Nebraska High school Championship.
- 4. The highest finishing varsity Nebraska boy's and girl's teams, not yet qualified, will qualify for the Nebraska High School Championships. Qualifying points for the NHSBCA Championship will be awarded to the top 10 teams.
- 5. There will be separate divisions for boys and girl's varsity and junior varsity.
- 6. Playing strength of each team shall be 5 (BOYS) 4 (GIRLS), a team's roster may carry up to 6 players.
- 7. Absent Bowler Rule for 2018 2019 Season. If a team is short a bowler they may still bowl qualifying with a sub if no subs are available then they may use the blind score from the Absent Bowler Chart

- 9. Substitutions are not allowed during a game, qualifying or baker, except in case of extreme accident or injury. Line-up may change, .
- 10. Multiple team participation in the events will be allowed.
- 11. Tournament format: (SEE FRONT)
- 12. All players, coaches and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and/or gestures will not be tolerated and may result in a player or teams being ejected from the tournament.
- 13. Players, two coaches per team and the tournament officials only will be allowed in the bowling area. All other spectators must remain behind the bowling area.
- 14. Awards will be provided by the Bellevue Area Bowling Club as followed:

Each Division:

One 1st Place team trophy or plaque as determined by tournament director.

1st - 4th Place individual awards (medals, or plaques as determined by tournament director)

1st and 2nd All Tournament Team

High game and series awards in both boys and girls divisions.

- 15. Scholarships awarded will be using smart account #11594. Scholarship amounts will be announced at the coaches meeting.
- 16. Any rule not covered here will be settled in accordance to USBC playing rules or newly adopted NHSBCA rules
- 17. Any changes announced prior to beginning competition will take precedence.
- 18. USBC Rule 308 requires all award fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100 percent to the participants in that event or division of that event.
