Tournament Rules:

- 1. The North Bend Invitational Tournament is sponsored by the North Bend Bowling Club and is open to all bowling teams of High School students in good academic standing and attending high school. (Public or private) Teams are composed of students attending one particular school unless approved by the tournament director prior to the tournament. In case of bad weather or a player not showing up, a team may borrow another team's player only by the approval of the tournament director.**
- 2. Entry fee is \$75.00 for Boys & \$65.00 for girls per team. PLEASE PAY IN ADVANCE. Prize fund returned 100% in awards. Awards are given for 1st & 2nd Place. All extra awards money will be in scholarships. Awards will be provided by the North Bend Bowling Club as follows:**

Scholarships:

All - Tournament Teams

1st Place team – Scholarship for each Member

2nd Place team - Scholarship for each Member

All-Tournament Team and High Game & Series Awards

- 3. All bowlers must be USBC sanctioned. Participation fee will be required if no sanction card.**
- 4. All competition will be scratch.**
- 5. There will be separate bowling divisions for boys and girls.**
- 6. Playing strength of each team shall be 5 bowlers for boys and 4 for girls, although a team's roster may carry eight players. Straw scores will be set prior per NHSBCA guidelines.**
- 7. Substitutes are not allowed during a match except in the case of extreme accident or injury. Line-up may change at the beginning each game.**
- 8. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Some sessions may fill up.**
- 9. Tournament Format: All teams will bowl 3 games of regular bowling, then 7 baker round robin games. 50% of pin total of the 3 regular games and 100% of the 7 baker game total plus bonus points will Determine advancers to the semifinals. Bonus points during baker qualifying awards 30 points for win & 15 points for tie. Top 4 teams will Advance to bracket final. 1st seed vs 4th seed, 2nd seed vs 3rd seed. Best 2 out of 3 baker games wins. Advancers from each of semifinal matches will bowl for the title, best 2 out of 3. All ties will be determined by a 10th frame roll off.**
- 10. All coaches, players, and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior and gestures will not be tolerated and may result in player or team removal.**
- 11. Players, two coaches per team, and tournament officials are allowed in the bowling area.**
- 12. Smart account #11183 will be used for Scholarships awarded.**
- 13. Any rules not covered here will be settled in accordance to USBC playing rules.**
- 14. Any changes announced prior to beginning of competition will take precedence.**
