1. This tournament is open to all bowling teams per NHSBCA guidelines. All Players must be in good standing and attending high school (public or private). All varsity players must be in grades $9-12$. Team members are composed of students attending one particular school unless approved by the tournament director prior to play.
2. This tournament is sanctioned by the USBC. All participants must hold a current USBC membership card. Non-members must pay a $\$ 2$ tournament participation fee.
3. Varsity \& JV Boys Entry Fee is $\$ 75 /$ Team (Bowling \$50, Awards/Expense $\$ 20$, NHSBCA \$5) Varsity \& JV Girls Entry Fee is \$60/Team (Bowling \$40, Awards/Expenses \$15, NHSBCA \$5)
4. There will be 4 separate tournaments for JV boys and JV girls (Saturday) as well as Varsity Boys and Varsity Girls (Sunday
5. Playing strength will be 5 bowlers for the boys and 4 bowlers for the girls; team may carry up to 7 Bowlers on their roster. Teams that are short a bowler may use a approved substitute or utilize a vacant score (see absent bowler chart below. Absent score for Bakers will be $4 / 5$ for each frame. If two bowlers are absent, baker score will be used in $1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }}$ frame etc.

6. All Competition is scratch
7. Substitutions are not allowed during a match except in case of extreme accident or injury. New bowler must be inserted in injured bowlers spot. Line up may change the subsequent game.
8. All team will bowl 3 regular games \& 3 bakers. The top 6 will advance. Teams finishing $1^{\text {st }} \& 2^{\text {nd }}$ are automatically seeded in the finals. $3^{\text {rd }}$ Place will face $6^{\text {th }}$ Place and $4^{\text {th }}$ Place will face $5^{\text {th }}$ Place in a best 2 of 3 eliminator. Winners Advance
9. Semifinals and finals will use bakers for all matches (Based on Position).
10. All Players, coaches, and spectators are expected to behave in a positive manner. Abusive behavior/gestures will not be tolerated and may result in player/team disqualification.
11. Only tournament officials, players, and up to two coaches per team are allowed in the bowling area during competition.
12. Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
13. Awards will be provided as follows:

A $\quad 1^{\text {st }}-3^{\text {rd }}$ Place Individual Medals
B. Top unqualified team will qualify for State Championship
C. All tournament team, high game and high series certificates will be awarded
D. High game and high series awards each division
E. USBC youth playing rules will govern all unstated issues
F. All smart money will go into Smart Account 11185.
